

# Commercial Pilot License (CPL) - Basic Facts

**Minimum Age:** 18

**Maximum Age:** There is no age limit as long as you have a valid aviation medical exam and can perform aircraft operation safely.

**Other Requirements:** You need to be able to read, understand and speak the English language. **250 hours** of total flight time. **For detailed requirements read the appropriated section in the FAR/AIM 61.121 through 61.133**

**Duration:** If you have already at least 230 hours of aeronautical experience: CPL Single 2 weeks full time. CPL Multi 2 weeks full time. If you start from scratch: Zero to Commercial Single and Multi IFR 16 - 18 weeks.

**Program:** We are using the Jeppesen Curriculum and Syllabus for all training levels. Theory is done with the instructor on a 1:1 or 1:2 basis. We also offer online courses and classes.

**Written Test:** Question pool comprises about 900 questions, multiple choice, 3 answers. Actual test 100 questions. Minimum passing rate 70%. Test preparation books: Gleim or Jeppesen.

**Instructors:** Only our most experienced and qualified instructor will teach commercial classes. You can expect a well prepared, efficient and professional training.

**Airport:** Our airport is an ideal training facility for all training levels with an active tower, friendly controllers and minimum waiting or taxi time.
