

G1000 Course – Basic Facts

The Garmin G1000 is a state of the art navigation system which needs thorough training and examination. There are so many features in this new system that you need to take some time and get thoroughly trained.

VFR Course: The VFR indoctrination takes about 2 hours of Ground School and 2-3 hours of Flight Time.

IFR Course: If you have a IFR Rating (based on ‘steam gauges’) you need about 5 additional hours to get used to the new panel and system. You need to fly at least 10 approaches before we can sign you off for IFR operation.

Simulators: A computer based G1000 Simulator with the GFC700 Auto Pilot is available for active pilots. We also offer Simulator lessons on a G1000 Table Model when accessible. Check our User Forum for available dates.
